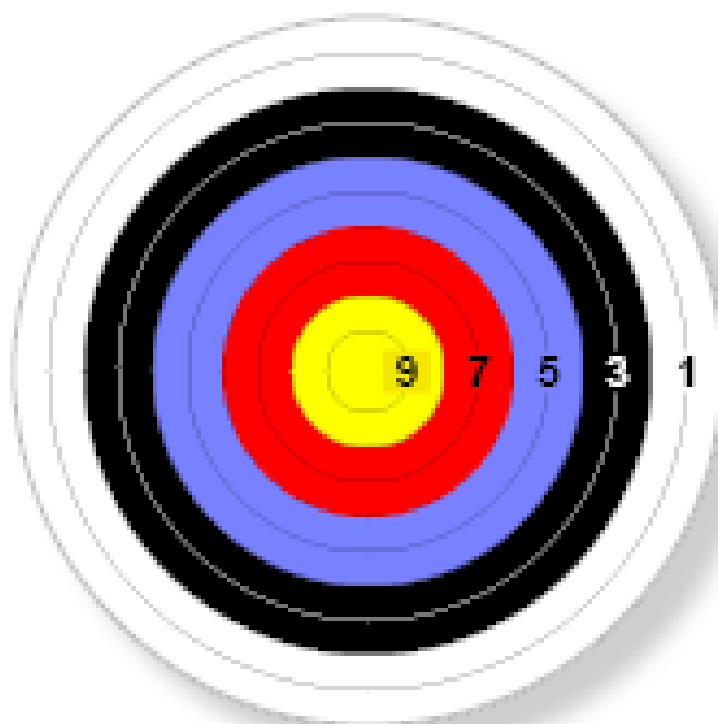


252 Badge

The '252' Recurve classification scheme is designed to provide a continual challenge for both novice and experienced archers. The scheme is based on one designed and used by Ascham Archers. To qualify for a particular classification the archer must score 252 points with three dozen arrows shot consecutively at a specified distance. This means scoring an average of seven points per arrow and can be obtained while shooting many of the outdoor rounds. Each classification is denoted by a colour and a distance. Longbows and Compound bows have a different score requirement to reflect the nature of each bow.
